GET AHEAD BY TAKING THESE CCSF COURSES

Here are the courses that meet USF's computer science degree requirements. While not required for admission, taking these courses before transferring will ensure you complete your USF degree sooner.

REQUIRED USF COURSE	CCSF EQUIVALENT COURSE
Intro to Computer Science I	Any one of the following: CS 110A, CS 111A, CS 111B, CS 131A, or CS 212
Intro to Computer Science II	CS 110B
Data Structure & Algorithms	CS 245
Calculus and Analytic Geometry	MATH 100A or MATH 110A
Linear Algebra and Probability	MATH 130

TO FULFILL USF'S CORE CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS, YOU CAN ALSO TAKE ONE COURSE EACH IN:

- Public Speaking
- Social Sciences
- Literature
- History
- Philosophy
- Ethics
- Religion
- Visual and Performing Arts
- Cultural Diversity
(This may be double counted with a Core Curriculum and/or major requirement)

GENERAL TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for transfer admission, you need:

- At least 24 semester or 36 quarter credits
- Cumulative college GPA of 2.5 or higher
- To be in academic and disciplinary good standing. USF defines good standing as having a term GPA of 2.00 or higher in the most recent term completed.

Ask your counselor about a special scholarship for CCSF students.
